**PROCLAMATION OF ELECTION FOR MEMBERS OF THE
BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

Election Date: Tuesday, January 14, 2014

On Tuesday, January 14, 2014, there shall be a regular election of the Alto Lakes Water & Sanitation District (the "District"). Election hours will be from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

The purpose of the election is to elect three (3) members of the Board of Directors of the District. Two shall serve for a term of six (6) years. One shall serve two (2) years. The Candidates receiving the most votes for the 6-year terms will be elected to Positions #1 and #2. The Candidate receiving the most votes for the 2-year term will be elected to Position #3.

Declarations of Candidacy for Position #1, #2, and #3 may be filed in person at the Office of the Alto Lakes Water and Sanitation District during normal business hours between the dates of November 27, 2013 to December 13, 2013.

A consolidated polling place for Lincoln County precincts 5.3, 5.4, and for qualified electors of the District residing elsewhere in New Mexico will be located at the Alto Lakes Water and Sanitation District Office located at 214 Lake Shore Drive, Alto, New Mexico 88312.

Only qualified electors of the Alto Lakes Water & Sanitation District shall be eligible to vote in this election. A qualified elector is a person who is registered to vote in any precinct in New Mexico; AND who:

- (1) is a resident of the District;
- (2) is a water service customer who is liable to pay the District's water rates; OR
- (3) is a landowner or land purchaser who is liable to pay property taxes on real property located in the District.

Non-residents of the District will be required to provide proof that they are qualified electors of the District.

The registration books for voting in this election will be closed by the Lincoln County Clerk on December 13, 2013.

The election will be by paper ballot and the District Secretary will appoint the precinct officials.

Absent Voting: Applications for absentee ballots may be made only on a form available from the Alto Lakes Water and Sanitation District. Application forms may be requested by mail or telephone message directed to the Alto Lakes Water and Sanitation District, PO Box 750, Alto, New Mexico 88312, telephone (575)336-4333, between November 15, 2013 and December 31, 2013. Applications for absentee ballots may be obtained and submitted in person during regular business hours at the Alto Lakes Water and Sanitation District Office, 214 Lake Shore Drive Alto, New Mexico, until 5:00 PM on Monday, January 13, 2014. Absentee ballots will be mailed commencing December 20, 2013. Completed absentee ballots must be received no later than 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 13, 2014. Completed absentee ballots may be delivered by mail or courier, or may be delivered in person to the Alto Lakes Water District office during regular business hours until 5:00 PM, January 13, 2014.

This Proclamation is made and published by a Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Alto Lakes Water & Sanitation District adopted October 24, 2014.
