



- 3. THE CONTRACTOR IS SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR CONSTRUCTING THE WATER MAIN LINE ACCORDING TO NEW MEXICO STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION (NMSSPWC) SECTIONS 701, 710 AND 900, UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED.
- 4. CONTRACTOR IS SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR UTILITY LOCATION, PROTECTION, AND VERIFICATION. CONTRACTOR MUST NOTIFY NEW MEXICO ONE CALL SYSTEM. INC. AT 811 OR 1-800-321-2537, PER 62-14-5 NMSA 1978, AND ALL LOCAL UTILITY PROVIDERS, TWO (2) DAYS BEFORE STARTING UTILITY LINE CONSTRUCTION.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE TO OBTAIN AND COMPLY WITH THE STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN (SWPPP). COST ASSOCIATED WITH THE SWPPP SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF WORK.
- 6. ALL WATER MAIN LINES & SERVICES AT UTILITY CROSSING SHALL REFERENCE SHEET D103.
- 7. ALL VALVES NOTED IN THE PLANS, OUTSIDE OF ENCLOSED STANDING STRUCTURES, SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED ACCORDING TO THE SPECIFICATIONS SHOWN IN THE "UTILITY DETAILS" SECTION OF THIS PLAN SET. EXCEPTIONS MUST BE AUTHORIZED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 8. ALL WATERLINES SHALL BE INSTALLED TO A MINIMUM COVER OF THIRTY—SIX (36) INCHES UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE. THIS INCLUDES ANY CROSSING SERVICES OR LATERALS INSTALLED. EXCEPTIONS MUST BE AUTHORIZED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 9. THE CONTRACTOR WILL PREPARE SETS OF WATER MAIN LINE "RECORD DRAWINGS" FOR THE PROJECT AND DELIVER THREE (3) SETS OF THESE DRAWINGS WITH REDLINES TO THE OWNER UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT.




PLAN VIEW JOINT RESTRAINT FOR PLUG/CAP




PLAN VIEW JOINT RESTRAINT FOR PVC ELBOWS (FOR 90°, 45° AND 22 1/2° SEE TABLE)
